Weekly Introduction

- What were the instructions Moses gave the people?
- Can you think of people in your life that you trust? Who trusts you?
- How can you show generosity and trust to others?
- What has God given you that you are thankful for?

3^{rd} Grade – 5^{th} Grade

- What surprises did you hear in this story?
- Did God's people follow the instructions that Moses gave them?
- Can you think of times that you were generous to others or someone was generous to you?
- How do we feel when we receive God's generosity?
