Weekly Introduction

This month our theme for Pathways to Discipleship is Generosity. Each week we will learn about ways we can be generous towards God, one another and ourselves. This week, the children will hear about a woman who is poor but she has a desire to please God so she shares all the money she has with others. Jesus calls us to give from the heart, trusting that God is a God of abundance. Jesus appreciates all gifts, even the small ones; especially when they are given out of love for God.

Scripture Lesson:

Read Mark 12:41-44 from your favorite Bible.

Questions for Engagement:

Kindergarteners to 2nd Grade

- Who gave only two coins?
- In this story, who was Jesus teaching?
- How do you think the little boy feels that shared his food with everyone?
- Can you think of times that you shared something of yours with someone? How did it make you feel?
- How can you show God's love to others?

3rd Grade – 5th Grade

- Why does Jesus say that the widow gave more than the others?
- In what ways do you give to God?
- Can you think of times that you were generous to others or someone was generous to you?
- How can you be generous and share God's love to others?
