



October – Generosity

Week 2 – Sunday, October 11, 2020 – Feeding Elijah (1 King 17:1-7)

Weekly Introduction

This month our theme for Pathways to Discipleship is Generosity. Each week we will learn about ways we can be generous towards God, one another and ourselves. This week, the children will hear about a man named Elijah chosen by God as a prophet. Just as God cares for us, God cared for Elijah and brought him food to eat and water to drink. God is generous and shows love for us by caring and providing for us.

Scripture Lesson:

Read 1 King 17:1-7 from your favorite Bible.

Questions for Engagement:

Kindergarteners to 2nd Grade

- How did Elijah get food when he was by the stream?
- Can you think of people in your life that care for you and take care of you? God cares for us all the time! God gives you people in your life to take care of you because he loves you and cares for you as well.
- How can you show generosity and care to others? How can you show God's love to others?
- What has God given you that you are thankful for?

3rd Grade – 5th Grade

- What surprises did you hear in this story?
- How did Elijah get food and water by the stream?
- Can you think of times that you were generous and caring to others or someone was generous and caring to you?
- How can you show God's love and care to your family, friends, neighbors, folks in our community and our church?
- How can you show God's love to yourself?
- How do we feel when we receive God's love and generosity?
